Attendance

Attendance has been carefully monitored since the start of the school year, in the light of attendance changes since August 2024. All schools aim for 96% attendance, which is the National recommendation. Letters and calls are made to families where children's attendance drops below 92% attendance as this puts them at risk of persistent absence.

Overall, Whitwell Primary School attendance from September to date is: 93.68%.

I have broken this down to each Year Group. Well done to Y6, Y5and Y1 for being closest to the expected figures.

There have been a lot of children and staff with Covid and cold viruses, but thankfully we seem to be over the worst now and everyone is improving. This should mean that our attendance rates are now climbing back up to at least 96%. Attendance is celebrated in school and each class with the highest attendance each week receives a certificate. Once a class has five certificates, they receive a treat afternoon of their choice! Also, did you know that our children are rewarded every day with 1 Wellian for attending and get a bonus 5 if they are here the whole week!

Qualitas After School Care

Due to low numbers of children attending, the Qualitas Childcare Provision will not continue after half-term.


